These processes included research on candidates and ballot measures, interviews of candidates and issues advocates, and votes by delegate and executive board bodies to determine whether a candidate or ballot measure should receive a labor endorsement.

Candidates must demonstrate that they support the values and work of UA 230, labor unions and our members. Our Union endorsed these candidates and initiatives, and we need you to vote for them.

If there is a race or issue that is not on this card, but is on your ballot, it means candidates or advocates for the issue did not seek or receive an endorsement from the San Diego Building Trades Council and/or the San Diego & Imperial Counties Labor Council or that of our UA 230 Political Education Committee.

**Election Day is Tuesday, March 3, 2020.**

If you recently moved, changed your name, or want to change your political party, you need to re-register to vote. You should be registered to vote at least 15 days before an election. You can register to vote online at <http://registertovote.ca.gov/>
